PREREQUISITES: A bachelor's degree from an accredited university and the TOEFL examination for non-native speakers of English.

CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS: Successful completion of the four required courses and any two elective courses is necessary to receive the Certificate in Project Management. Coursework must be completed within a two-year period. Project Management Fundamentals is a prerequisite for all project management courses. All courses satisfy the 35-hour education criteria necessary to be eligible to take the PMP Exam with the PMI. Continuing education courses do not count toward the certificate but are eligible for Professional Development Units (PDUs) with the PMI.
